RE: Environmental Emergency (E2) – Public Notification

Husky Energy (Husky), as the owner of oil and gas facilities that contain regulated substances, has created emergency response plans to maintain the safety and well-being of local residents. As someone who resides or runs a business in an emergency planning zone associated with these facilities, Husky has a responsibility to inform you about the regulated substances stored on site.

The health and safety of our employees, contractors and the communities in which we operate is our top priority. Husky is committed to:

- responsible corporate citizenship, operational integrity and environmental stewardship.
- conducting all activities safely and reliably so the public is protected, impact to the environment is minimized, and the health and well-being of employees is safeguarded.
- keeping people informed of our activities and working together to address concerns.

Husky has assessed the regulated substance storage at our facilities and identified potential scenarios that could lead to an unplanned release. The unplanned release of these regulated substances is extremely unlikely, however, these potential scenarios could include fire, unloading incidents, pipe-system failure and container damage.

In the event that an unplanned release occurs, we would respond immediately by enacting our emergency response plan which includes notification of local authorities.

We take the following steps to ensure safe and reliable use of regulated substances at our locations:

- Each location has a site-specific emergency response plan to guide how we will respond. All emergency plans are updated and reviewed at least once a year. Husky also has a corporate response team that is ready to assist 24/7.
- Personnel at this site are trained to know what to do in the event of an emergency. Exercises are conducted at least annually.
- Husky Operations and Safety personnel visit all sites to maintain the safety of all employees, contractors and the public.
- Supplier-led inspections by qualified personnel ensure the safety and integrity of the infrastructure.
- Husky follows an extensive corporate system designed to ensure high operational integrity at all our sites. This system is reviewed regularly.
- Husky provides local emergency responders with a copy of the emergency response plan to lead response actions and implement public protection measures.
