Expression of Interest (EOI) / Prequalification
Full Field Certifying Authority Services Reference 8.24.1.326

Cenovus Energy Inc. (Cenovus), Operator of the White Rose field and satellite extensions, is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) and Prequalification responses from interested companies for the provision of **Full Field Offshore Certifying Authority Services** for the White Rose field, to support both West White Rose Platform (WWRP) and the SeaRose FPSO.

Interested companies must be qualified to conduct the work scope and the prequalification questionnaire on Cenovus' website under Reference No. **8.24.1.326**. Respondents are required to demonstrate their capabilities and experience via a formal response to this EOI/Prequalification advertisement.

Scope Overview

Cenovus requires the services of a recognized classification society capable and interested in acting as Certifying Authority during production operations, in accordance with the Newfoundland Offshore Certificate of Fitness Regulations (to be repealed and replaced with Part 3 of the Newfoundland Offshore Area Oil and Gas Operations Regulations scheduled for issue in 2023). The intent is to have one Certifying Authority (CA) covering all operating assets for the field.

The scope of work for the provision of Certifying Authority services will include, but not be limited to the following:

- Execution of all requirements of the Certifying Authority, as outlined in the *Newfoundland & Labrador Offshore Certificate of Fitness Regulations*. This may include but is not limited to submission of scope(s) of work, agreed with Operator for the White Rose Field, to the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board for approval.
 - Ongoing verification of the Certificate of Fitness (CoF) for the West White Rose Platform.
 - Ongoing verification of the Certificate of Fitness for the SeaRose FPSO, and subsea installations.
- Management of all flag state certification (Transport Canada Marine Safety (TCMS) delegate) and the classification of the FPSO hull and marine systems. The hull is Det Norske Veritas classed with the following notations: 1A1 Ship-shaped Oil production storage unit, COAT-2, ECO, HELDK, ICS, NAUTICUS (Newbuilding), POSMOOR, PROD, TMON (oil lubricated).

Timeline Requirements

Respondents are required to provide an optimal transition plan and timing while considering the following key dates:

- A life extension dry dock is scheduled for 2024. The SeaRose will return to field prior to the arrival of the West White Rose platform with full term CoF, Flag and Class certificates valid until August 2025.
- Offshore hook up and remaining commissioning of the West White Rose platform is scheduled for Q2/Q3, 2025. A Certificate of Fitness with limitations will be issued prior to habitation of the accommodations, see Attachment 1 for additional information.

Cenovus strongly supports providing opportunities to Canadians and, in particular, Newfoundland and Labrador companies and individuals, on a commercially competitive basis. Companies are required to complete a Canada/Newfoundland and Labrador Benefits Questionnaire as part of the Prequalification process. Cenovus also encourages the participation of members of designated groups (women; Aboriginal peoples; persons with disabilities; and members of visible minorities) and corporations or cooperatives owned by them, in the supply of goods and services.
